GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land encompassed in this survey is located about 15 miles northwest of Las Vegas, Nevada. The land is on a constant slope of alluvial soil, ranging from 3,300 ft. in the southwest part sloping to 2,700 ft. in elevation in the northeast part. The soil is generally sandy clay loam mixed with gravel and rocks.

Access into the area is provided by U.S. Highway No. 95, which crosses the township, entering in section 36 and leaving in section 27. There are several trail roads which provide access to the area, and also three power lines, one of which parallels an old railroad grade, all of which generally parallel each other in a northwest and southeast directions. No other improvements of note are located in the area.

The vegetation consists of scattered sagebrush and medium to heavy densities of cactus throughout the area. There are many small washes running in the general directions from southwest to northeast.
