	<p style="text-align: center;">T38N R61E <u>S 11 S 12</u> S 14 S 13</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1983</p> <p>Reset the original willow post, alongside the iron post.</p> <hr/> <p>From the cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set, showing 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 38 N., R. 62 E., executed concurrently under this same Group.</p> <p>N. 88° 38' W., bet. secs. 12 and 13.</p> <p>Over gently rolling land, through scattered sagebrush.</p> <p>41.94 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 12 and 13, determined at the corner of fences, bearing N. and W. This fence corner is locally recognized as the cor. and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p>

	<p>39.97 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 11 and 12, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p>
