

## TOWNSHIP 38 NORTH, RANGE 61 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 38 North, Range 61 East, is about 5,430 to 5,750 ft. above sea level and is mostly rolling. The soil varies from sandy clay loam and rocky on the higher elevations to black loam on the bottom land. The vegetation consists of sagebrush and native grass except along the bottom land which is covered with meadow grass. There are scattered stands of willow along the Humboldt River.

The Humboldt River drains the southern portion of the area flowing westerly from sec. 25 on the east boundary to sec. 31 on the west boundary of the township. Bishop Creek and Burnt Creek cross the township from NE. to SW.

The Western Pacific Railroad and the Southern Pacific Railroad cross the area from E. to W. Further access into the township is provided by improved roads and desert trail roads.

The Knudson Ranch is located in section 1.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
