80.72	<p>The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, monumented with a limestone, 14X10X8 ins., plainly mkd. with 5 grooves on E. face and 1 groove on W. face, firmly set at a fence corner, fences bear E. and S.</p> <p>This corner now refers to secs. 5 and 6 only.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2<math>\frac{1}{2}</math> ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p>
