From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, Tps. 38 and 38½ N., R. 62 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set showing 4 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the north boundary of T. 38 N., R. 62 E., executed concurrently under this same Group.

NORTH, bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over mountainous land, through scattered sagebrush.
