

TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 67 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within the confines of this survey in Township 1 North, Range 67 East, located at Caselton which is approximately 2 miles southwest of Pioche, Nevada ranges from 5900 to 6500 ft. above sea level and is mostly gently rolling, approaching a mountain range at the eastern edge. The soil is clayish with a medium to heavy concentration of limestone. The vegetation consists of light to medium densities of juniper and pinon pine with scattered sagebrush and sparse cactus.

Access is gained to this area by Nevada Highway No. 320, which enters at the northwest part of section 29 bearing southeasterly. There is an improved road entering Caselton and numerous other trail roads in the area. A Union Pacific railroad spur, which bears from northwest to southeast, is in the process of being dismantled. A power substation is located in the northeast part of section 29 with a transmission line leading to and from it. There are numerous mines in the area.

Principal users of the area are miners, the power company, a cement plant and local residents of Caselton.
