CHAINS 73.17	The cor. of California fractional secs. 19 and 30, T. 22 N., R. 18 E., monumented with a granite stone, 30X10X10 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, plainly mkd. with 2 grooves on S. face and 4 grooves on N. face, bears EAST, 0.06 chs. dist.
79.97	Mile Post No. 155, monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 2 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the retracement of the Nevada - California State Line, between Mile Posts 155 and 157, executed under Group No. 126.

<p>From the cor. of Tps. 21 and 22 N., Rs. 18 and 19 E., identical with a U.S.G.S. triangulation station, monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set in a concrete cylinder, 8 ins. diam., exposed 4 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the W. bdy. of T. 21 N., R. 19 E., executed under Group No. 312.</p>	
<p>N. 89° 59' W., bet. secs. 1 and 36.</p>	
<p>Over rolling land, through scattered sagebrush, Brigham tea, native grass and juniper; along fence.</p>	
33.10	Ridge, bears N. and S., desc. W. slope.
39.24	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
<p>Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a collar of stone, 3 ft. base to top, with aluminum cap mkd.</p>
