

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE EAST BOUNDARY,
T. 35 N., R. 69 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

From this corner, a limestone, 14X10X9 ins., firmly set in a mound of earth, showing 11 ins. above ground, plainly mkd. with $\frac{1}{4}$ on the W. face, bears S. 19° 55' E., 2.60 chs. dist. This corner now becomes an amended monument. Add the marks AM to cornerstone and bury in place. This is a corner of no record.

N. 0° 16' E., beginning new measurement.

Over rolling land.

13.60 Wash, 40 lks. wide, 5 ft. deep, drains S. 40° W.

39.60 Intersect the closing cor. of Tps. 35 N., Rs. 69 and 70 E., monumented with a limestone, 24X12X9 ins., firmly set in a mound of earth, plainly mkd. with 6 notches on the E. and W. edges and 6 grooves and CC on the S. face. This corner now becomes an amended monument. Add the marks AM to cornerstone and bury in place.

39.75 Intersect the Seventh Standard Parallel North.

Point for the closing cor. of Tps. 35 N., Rs. 69 and 70 E.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Set a steel fence post, 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, alongside the iron post.

From this corner, the standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 36, T. 36 N., R. 69 E., monumented with an iron post, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set showing 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the Seventh Standard Parallel North, through Range 69 East, executed concurrently under this same Group, bears N. 89° 00' E., 0.84 chs. dist.
