	From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy. of the Tp.
	N. 0° 48' E., bet. secs. 35 and 36.
	Over rolling land, covered with sagebrush, rabbit brush and native grass.
28.40	Wash, 20 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains W.
34.30	Wash, 20 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains W.
40.60	Point for the $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

	Set a steel fence post, 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, alongside the iron post.
	From this corner, the NW. corner of a spring pump house, bears S. 10° 34' W., 10.84 chs. dist.
	From this same corner, a corner of fences, from which fences bear S. and W., bears S. 28 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 1.30 chs. dist.
45.40	Trail road, bears irregularly WNW. and ESE.
51.80	Wash, 20 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains WNW.
