

## TOWNSHIP 37 NORTH, RANGE 69 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

## CHAINS

## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within Township 37 North, Range 69 East, varies from mountainous in the southeast portion to nearly level in the central portion with the remaining terrain being rolling to gently rolling. The elevation ranges from about 4,800 to 6,700 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from rocky on the higher elevations to sandy clay loam on the lower elevations. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, shadscale, greasewood, rabbit brush, bunchgrass and other sparse native grass, with heavy stands of juniper and pinon pine in the southeast portion of the township.

The township is drained by Pilot Creek which drains from NE. to SW. There are water wells in sections 9 and 29.

The Bar O Ranch is located in section 14, and the Pilot Mountain Ranch and a reservoir are located in section 34.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen, and access into the township is provided by improved roads and numerous desert trail roads. No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
