

TOWNSHIP 31½ NORTH, RANGE 33 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land surveyed and resurveyed within Township 31½ North, Range 33 East, is mountainous. The elevation ranges from about 4,800 to 5,900 ft. above sea level. The soil is rocky clay. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, shadscale and native grass with juniper and pinon pine on the slopes and cottonwood, willows and rose bushes along the bottom of Humboldt Canyon. Drainage is supplied by Humboldt Canyon which drains in a northwesterly direction. Access is provided by a trail road paralleling Humboldt Canyon.

There are many tunnels and prospects in the surrounding area although none appear to be within the area of the township.
