

SURVEY OF THE SOUTH BOUNDARY,
T. 31 N., R. 33½ E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

Land, mountainous.
Soil, rocky clay.
Undergrowth, juniper, cacti, sagebrush and native grass.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land surveyed and resurveyed within Township 31 North, Range 33½ East, is mountainous. The elevation ranges from about 5,600 to 6,400 ft. above sea level. The soil consists of clay with rocky outcroppings. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, cacti and native grass with juniper and pinon pine on the slopes and cottonwood, willows and rose bushes along the bottom of Humboldt Canyon. Humboldt Canyon drains the area in a northwesterly direction. Access is provided by a trail road in Humboldt Canyon.

There was some mining activity noted during the survey of the township.
