



DEPENDENT AND INDEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF

	<p>Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  <p>T31N R33E S 2 MS 40 MA COR 2 1983</p> </div> <p>Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, E. of cor.</p> <hr/> <p>N. 1° 00' E., beginning new measurement.</p> <p>Over gently rolling land.</p> <p>17.90 Improved gravel road, bears WNW. and ESE.</p> <p>39.12 The closing cor. of secs. 2 and 3, identified by the 1919 and 1920 investigation survey, monumented with a squared redwood post, 3X2X42 ins. long, loosely set in a mound of earth, with a pine post, 4X4X18 ins. long, wired to the redwood post. This corner now becomes the cor. of secs. 2, 3 and 37.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  <p>T31N R33E S 3 S 2 S 37 1983</p> </div> <p>Reset the original wooden posts alongside the aluminum post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, S. of cor.</p> <p>From this corner, Cor. No. 2 of M.S. No. 40 (Office No. 1448), Madre lode, hereinbefore described, bears S. 31° 09' E., 48.52 chs. dist.</p> <hr/> <p>From the cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22, 23 and 39.</p> <p>N. 2° 20' W., along the E. bdy. of sec. 15.</p> <p>Over rolling land, covered with scattered sagebrush, rabbitbrush and bunchgrass.</p> <p>27.50 Wash, in Black Canyon, 15 lks. wide, 5 ft. deep, drains W.</p> <p>31.00 Trail road, bears E. and W.</p>
