SURVEY OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES OF
T. 34 N., R. 54½ E., MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

From the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set showing 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 34 N., R. 55 E., executed concurrently under this same Group.

From this corner, U.S.C. & G.S. triangulation station "KEY," monumented with a standard brass tablet set in the top of a concrete monument, 6 ins. diam., projecting 3 ins. above the ground, with brass tablet mkd. "KEY 1957," bears N. 58° 42' E., 22.70 chs. dist.

WEST, bet. secs. 24 and 25.

Over rolling land, covered with scattered undergrowth.

6.08 Intersect the E. bdy. of sec. 25, T. 34 N., R. 54 E.

Point for the closing cor. of secs. 24 and 25.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, alongside the iron post.

From this corner, the cor. of secs. 24 and 25, T. 34 N., R. 54 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 4 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 34 N., R. 54 E., executed concurrently under this same Group, bears N. 0° 07' E., 4.73 chs. dist.

From this same corner, U.S.C. & G.S. Bench Mark, monumented with a standard brass tablet set in the top of a concrete monument, 4 ins. diam., exposed 6 ins. above the ground, with brass tablet mkd. "L 141 1957," bears S. 8° 47' E., 19.51 chs. dist.

Land, rolling.

Soil, sandy clay and gravelly.

Undergrowth, sagebrush and cheatgrass.
