Set a steel fence post, 5 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. long, alongside the iron post.

From this corner, the E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 13, T. 34 N., R. 54 E., monumented with an iron post, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 4 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 34 N., R. 54 E., executed concurrently under this same Group, bears N. 0° 48' E., 1.52 chs. dist.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area surveyed within Township 34 North, Range 54 $\frac{1}{2}$  East, is situated about 3 miles W. of Elko, Nevada. The elevation varies from 5,100 to 5,400 feet above sea level. The soil consists of sandy clay and gravel. The vegetation consists of scattered sagebrush and cheatgrass. There is no timber in the township.

Access into the township is provided by numerous desert trail roads.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
