	GENERAL DESCRIPTION
	The area resurveyed within Township 33 North, Range 55 East is situated about 3 miles SW. of Elko, Nevada. The elevation varies from 5,000 to 5,700 feet above sea level and is gently rolling to rolling.
	The soil varies from sandy clay in the northern portion to gravelly and rocky in the southern portion.
	The vegetation consists of sagebrush, rabbitbrush, greasewood and cheatgrass, with scattered juniper on the higher elevations.
	Access into the township is provided by Bullion Road, which crosses southerly through sections 6 and 7, and numerous other desert trail roads.
	There is a well and windmill located in the NW. corner of section 7. Principal users of the area are cattlemen.
	No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.
