34.00	<p>The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set and exposed 4 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the S. boundary of T. 34 N., R. 55 E., executed concurrently under this same Group.</p> <hr/> <p>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The area resurveyed within Township 33 North, Range 55 East is situated about 3 miles SW. of Elko, Nevada. The elevation varies from 5,000 to 5,700 feet above sea level and is gently rolling to rolling.</p> <p>The soil varies from sandy clay in the northern portion to gravelly and rocky in the southern portion.</p> <p>The vegetation consists of sagebrush, rabbitbrush, greasewood and cheatgrass, with scattered juniper on the higher elevations.</p> <p>Access into the township is provided by Bullion Road, which crosses southerly through sections 6 and 7, and numerous other desert trail roads.</p> <p>There is a well and windmill located in the NW. corner of section 7. Principal users of the area are cattlemen.</p> <p>No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p> <hr/>
