<p>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>Township 31 North, Range 56 East, is situated about 20 miles south southeast of Elko, Nevada. The elevation varies from 5,600 to 6,200 feet above sea level. The soil varies from silt along the river bottom to sandy loam in the higher elevations.</p> <p>The South Fork Humboldt River crosses the township from east to northwest. Willow Creek drains the southern portion of the township.</p> <p>The principal users of the township are cattlemen and sheepmen.</p> <p>Access into the township is provided by numerous improved roads.</p> <p>There are scattered juniper on the higher elevations of little commercial value.</p> <p>The vegetation consists of sagebrush and native grass.</p> <p>No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.</p>
