40.71	<p>Point for the <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> sec. cor. of secs. 7 and 18, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, <math>2\frac{1}{2}</math> ins. diam., 23 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div><div>T31N R57E</div><div><div><math>\frac{1}{4}</math></div><div><div>S 7</div><div>S 18</div></div></div></div> <p>1974</p>
