	<p style="text-align: center;">GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The land encompassed within Township 39 North, Range 62 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada is mostly mountainous in the eastern portion and nearly level to gently rolling in the western portion of the township. The elevation ranges from 5,600 to 7,400 feet above sea level. Vegetation consists of sagebrush, buckbrush, manzanita, cheatgrass, crested wheat grass and juniper in the mountains.</p> <p>There are three principal drainages in the area: Bishop Creek originating at Bishop Creek Reservoir located in section 13, Finks Canyon originating in sections 10 and 11, and Trout Creek entering in sections 3, all of which drain southwesterly, leaving the township in section 31.</p> <p>There are several trail roads in the area and one principal improved road in the western part. This improved road accesses the several ranches that exist in the lower western area.</p> <p>Principal users of this township are ranchers and hunters.</p>
