

TOWNSHIP 38 NORTH, RANGE 62 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

The following field notes are those of the retracement of the south one-half mile of the west boundary and the south one-half mile of the east boundary of sec. 31, Township 38 North, Range 62 East, Mount Diablo Meridian, Nevada.

History pertains to sec. 31 only.

The east and south boundaries were surveyed by U.S. Deputy Surveyor C. C. Tracy in 1868 and 1869 under Contract No. 21.

The north and east boundaries were surveyed by U.S. Deputy Surveyors A. J. Hatch and J. H. Eaton in 1870 under Contract No. 36.

In 1983 Cadastral Surveyor R. A. Pratt, under Group No. 605, resurveyed the north, south, east and west boundaries of sec. 31.

The survey was executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1973, and the Special Instructions dated October 4, 1985.

The directions of the lines of this survey were determined by azimuth taken from U.S.C. & G.S. triangulation station "METRO," located in section 21. The directions of the lines were carried forward by sustained angulation.

The vertical angles of measurements made on the slope were ascertained with a theodolite in good adjustment; the horizontal equivalents only are entered in the field notes.

The mean magnetic declination was found to be $17\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E.

RETRACEMENT OF THE SOUTH ONE-HALF MILE

Retracement of the Dependent Resurvey Executed by
Robert A. Pratt, Cadastral Surveyor, in 1983.

From the cor. of Tps. 37 and 38 N., Rs. 61 and 62 E., monumented with an aluminum post, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set showing 14 ins. above the ground, with steel fence post firmly set alongside, with aluminum cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 37 N., R. 61 E., executed under Group No. 584.
