CHAINS

Reset the rebar and set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, alongside the aluminum post.

N. 89° 58' W., beginning new measurement.

Over nearly level land.

The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, monumented with a rebar, 5/8 ins. diam., 16 ins. long, firmly set in a mound of stone. This is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.

At the corner point

Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.
