From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy.  
of the Tp.

N. 0° 25' W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over nearly level land, covered with scattered  
sagebrush and bunchgrass.

18.40 Hot Creek Road, improved, bears WNW. and ESE.

41.08 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, monumented with a  
granite stone, 14X8X6 ins., firmly set 6 ins. in the  
ground and dimly mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face.

At the corner point

Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24  
ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.

Deposit the original cornerstone and set a steel fence  
post, 5 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. long, alongside the aluminum post.

N. 0° 38' W., beginning new measurement.

proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence  
of the original corner.

Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24  
ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.
