GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area surveyed and resurveyed within Township 8 North, Range 50 East, varies from mountainous in the western part to gently rolling in the remaining portion. The elevation ranges from about 5,500 to 6,600 ft. above sea level. The soil varies from sandy clay loam on the lower elevations and rocky on the higher elevations. The vegetation consists of mainly greasewood, sagebrush, sparse native grass and pinon pine and juniper in the mountains.
