iron post, 3 ins. diam., with brass cap mkd. as
described in the field notes of the resurvey of the
Ruby Valley Guide Meridian, T. 8 N., Rs. 55 and 56 E.,
executed under Group No. 37. This post is rusted off
at the surface, with the base section firmly set and
the upper section lying alongside.

At the corner point

Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24
ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.
