C. Tracy, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, in 1868.</p> <hr/> <p>From the cor. of secs. 19, 24, 25 and 30, monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set showing 2 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 22 N., R. 55 E., executed under Group No. 281. Add the marks 1984 to the brass cap.</p> <p>N. 0° 31' E., bet. secs. 19 and 24.</p> <p>Over nearly level land, covered with medium densities of sagebrush, greasewood, scattered rabbit brush and native grass.</p> <p>7.90 Fence, bears WNW. and ESE.</p> <p>40.00 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 19 and 24, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T23N R55E R56E ¼ S 24 S 19 1984</p> <p>Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.</p> <p>49.00 Fence, bears WNW. and ESE.</p> <p>70.60 Fence, parallels power line.</p> <p>70.70 Power line, bears N. 60½° E. and S. 60½° W.</p> <p>80.00 Point for the cor. of secs. 13, 18, 19 and 24, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.</p>
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
