80.00	<p>The cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, monumented with the decayed remains of a wooden post, with illegible scribe marks visible, loosely set in a mound of earth.</p> <p>At the corner point</p> <p>Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T24N R55E R56E S 1 S 6 S 12 S 7</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1984</p> <p>Reset the original wooden post and set a steel fence post, 5½ ft. long, alongside the aluminum post.</p>
41.02	<p>N. 0° 40' E., bet. secs. 1 and 6.</p> <p>Over gently rolling land, covered with medium densities of sagebrush and scattered rabbit brush, shadscale and native grass.</p> <p>Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.</p> <p>Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T24N R55E R56E ¼ S 1 S 6</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1984</p> <p>Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.</p>
82.04	<p>The cor. of Tps. 24 and 25 N., Rs. 55 and 56 E., monumented with an aluminum post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set showing 6 ins. above ground, with aluminum cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 25 N., R. 55 E., executed concurrently under this same Group.</p>
