39.61	The N. ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 1, T. 25 N., R. 55 E., hereinafter described.
39.91	The standard ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 36, monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set showing 6 ins. above ground, with a mound of stone N. of cor., with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 26 N., R. 55 E., executed under Group No. 577. Add the marks 1985 to the brass cap.

39.91	The standard cor. of secs. 35 and 36, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set showing 8 ins. above ground, with a mound of stone N. of cor., with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 26 N., R. 55 E., executed under Group No. 195. Add the marks 1985 to the brass cap.
	<hr/> <p>S. 89° 33' W., along the S. bdy. of sec. 35.</p> <p>Over gently rolling land, covered with scattered sagebrush, native grass and crested wheatgrass.</p>
