CHAINS	<p>Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base to top, with aluminum cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">NE 1/16 S24</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1986</p> <p>From this corner, the NE 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 24, erroneously established by Gardner and Hardin in 1974, monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, bears N. 77° 56' E., 1.14 chs. dist. Obliterate the marks on the brass cap and add the marks AM 1986.</p>

The soil consists of sandy clay loam and rocky, and the vegetation includes juniper, pinon pine, sagebrush and native grass.</p> <p>There are several washes draining primarily westerly in the area.
