CHAINS	<p>This corner is located identically with a 5/8 in. steel rebar, firmly set flush with the surface of the ground, with RLS tag No. 2518 Nevada. Place rebar inverted inside the aluminum post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, NW. of cor.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Thence N. 6° 41' E., on line 4-1.</p>

	<p>GENERAL DESCRIPTION</p> <p>The land within the confines of this survey in Township 2 North, Range 42 East is at the base of Mt. Butler, at the south end of Tonopah, Nevada. The elevation is about 6,400 ft. above sea level. The vegetation consists of sagebrush and native grass and the soil is sandy clay loam with limestone. There is an adit encompassed within this tract of land.</p>
