	<p>The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on the N. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with a steel fence post set alongside the iron post, and with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 17 N., R. 63 E., executed under Group No. 488. This corner now refers to secs. 5 and 6 only. 2.34	<p>Point for the cor. of secs. 31 and 32, T. 18 N., R. 63 E., established latitudinally on the N. bdy. of sec. 6, and longitudinally at 240.00 chs. in departure from the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, on the N. bdy. of the T. 17 N., R. 63 E.</p> <p>Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">T18N R63E S 31 S 32 S 6 T17N</p> <p style="text-align: center;">1986</p> <p>Raise a mound of stone, 2½ ft. base, 1½ ft. high, N. of cor.</p>
24.10	Trail road, parallels fence.
