From the cor. of Tps. 17 N., Rs. 62 and 63 E. N. 89° 01' W., along the N. bdy. of sec. 1. Over rolling land, covered with scattered sagebrush and native grass. 10.80 Trail road, bears NE. and SW. 19.70 Trail road, bears NW. and SE. 20.76 The closing cor. of Tps. 18 N., Rs. 62 and 63 E., hereinafter described. 24.90 Wash, 30 lks. wide, 5 ft. deep, drains SE. 40.38 The N $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. of sec. 1, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set showing 8 ins. above ground, with a steel fence post set alongside the iron post, and with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T. 17 N., R. 62 E., executed under Group No. 64.
