

SURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE SUBDIVISIONAL LINES,
T. 2 N., R. 56 E., MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

From this corner, the cor. of secs. 18 and 19, T. 2 N., R. 57 E., hereinbefore described, bears S. 0° 07' W., 1.74 chs. dist.

Land, rolling.

Soil, sandy clay loam and rocky.

Undergrowth, scattered sagebrush, Brigham tea, rabbitbrush and sparse cacti.

Timber, sparse juniper.

Point for the E $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 13, is at midpoint between the closing cors. and on the W. bdy. of sec. 18, T. 2 N., R. 57 E.

Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.

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Set a steel fence post, 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, alongside the aluminum post, and raise a mound of stone, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

From this corner, the W $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 18, T. 2 N., R. 57 E., hereinbefore described, bears S. 0° 03' W., 1.57 chs. dist.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within the confines of the survey in Township 2 North, Range 56 East, elevation generally ranges approximately 6,000 ft. above sea level and is rolling to mountainous land. The vegetation consists of scattered juniper, pinon pine, sagebrush, Brigham tea, rabbitbrush and sparse cacti. The soil is sandy clay loam and rocky. Cottonwood Creek flows southeasterly across the southern part of section 13.

Improvements consist of an improved gravel road bearing generally east and west in section 13 and a building under construction located in the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section 13.

Principal users of the area are landowners in the vicinity.
