The cor. of Tps. 39 and 40 N., Rs. 60 and 61 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 39 N., R. 60 E., executed under Group No. 405.

Reestablishment of the Dependent Resurvey Executed by
Stephen R. Lambeth, Cadastral Surveyor, in 1984.

From the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 13 and 18, monumented with a ring spike, firmly set 1 in. below the surface of the ground in an improved gravel road, bearing N. and S., mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 39 N., R. 62 E., executed concurrently under this same Group.

N. 0° 14' E., bet. secs. 13 and 18.

Over gently rolling land, along an improved gravel road.

Intersect right-of-way, Pacific Reclamation Company's canal, bears S. 49° 17' W. and N. 49° 17' E.

Set a steel spike, 6 ins. long, ¼ in. diam., flush in the ground in an improved gravel road, bears N. and S., mkd. with a cross (X) on top.

An iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., set 24 ins. in the ground, for a reference monument, bears N. 37½° E., 80.3 lks. dist., in a fence bearing N. and S., with brass cap mkd. RM S18 53 FT 1985 and an arrow pointing to the corner.

An iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., set 24 ins. in the ground, for a reference monument, bears N. 37° W., 80.3 lks. dist., in a fence bearing N. and S., with brass cap mkd. RM S13 53 FT 1985 and an arrow pointing to the corner.

Center line of canal, from which Station 56, not monumented, bears S. 49° 17' W., 11.537 chs. dist.

Canal, 20 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains SW.

Intersect right-of-way, Pacific Reclamation Company's canal, bears S. 49° 17' W. and N. 49° 17' E.
