CHAINS

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground on north bank of canal and east shoulder of road bearing N. and S., with brass cap mkd.

18.30 Fence corner, bears EAST, 0.47 chs. dist., from which fences bear N., S., and E.

18.905 Point for the N 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 13 and 18.

Set a steel spike, 6 ins. long, ¼ in. diam., flush with the ground in an improved gravel road bearing N. and S., mkd. with a cross (X) on top.

An iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., set 24 ins. in the ground, for a reference monument, bears N. 35° E., 75.8 lks. dist., with brass cap mkd. RM N 1/16 S18 50 FT 1985 and an arrow pointing to the corner.

An iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., set 24 ins. in the ground, for a reference monument, bears N. 42° W., 75.8 lks. dist., with brass cap mkd. RM N 1/16 S13 50 FT 1985 and an arrow pointing to the corner.

37.81 The cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13 and 18, monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set showing 4 ins. above ground in a corner of fences bearing S., E. and SE., with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of T. 39 N., R. 62 E., executed concurrently under this same Group.
