

## TOWNSHIP 40 NORTH, RANGE 20 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

## CHAINS

The geographic position for the E  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 28, is at latitude  $41^{\circ} 21' 21.55''$  N. and longitude  $119^{\circ} 44' 06.36''$  W. as calculated from U.S.G.S. triangulation station "CAMP," and the geographic position for the southeast cor. of the township is at latitude  $41^{\circ} 20' 03.4''$  N. and longitude  $119^{\circ} 40' 36.5''$  W. as calculated along section lines from triangulation station "CAMP."

The mean magnetic declination was found to be  $18^{\circ}$  E.

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF THE EIGHTH STANDARD PARALLEL  
NORTH, THROUGH RANGE 20 EAST,  
MOUNT DIABLO MERIDIAN, NEVADA

Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by  
G. W. Garside, U.S. Deputy Surveyor  
in 1878,  
and Resurveyed by R. K. Baugh and R. E. Williams,  
Cadastral Surveyors, in 1980.

The standard cor. of Tps. 41 N., Rs. 20 and 21 E.,  
monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set  
and exposed 8 ins. above the ground, with brass cap  
mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent  
resurvey of the Eighth Standard Parallel North, through  
Range 21 East, executed under Group No. 48.

N.  $89^{\circ} 16'$  W., along the S. bdy. of sec. 36.

Over rolling land, through scattered sagebrush and  
bunchgrass.

- 3.00 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains NNE.
- 9.00 Trail road, bears N. and S.
- 10.94 A trapstone, 18X6X6 ins., firmly set in a mound of  
stone, plainly mkd. as described in the field notes of  
the dependent resurvey of the Eighth Standard Parallel  
North, through Range 20 East, executed under Group No.  
587, bears SOUTH, 0.227 chs. dist.
- 30.79 The N  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 1, T. 40 N., R. 20 E.,  
hereinafter described.
- 39.99 The standard  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 36, monumented with an  
aluminum post,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of  
stone, 4 ft. base to cap, with aluminum cap mkd. as  
described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey  
of the Eighth Standard Parallel North, through Range 20  
East, executed under Group No. 587. Add the marks 1985  
to the aluminum cap.
