The closing cor. of secs. 22 and 23, T. 39½ N., R. 20 E., monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the resurvey of T. 39½ N., R. 20 E., executed under Group No. 12. Add the marks 1985 to the brass cap.

The cor. of secs. 34 and 35, monumented with a basalt stone, 23X13X10 ins., firmly set and exposed 6 ins. above the ground, plainly mkd. with 2 grooves on E. face and 4 grooves on W. face.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
