

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF THE WEST BOUNDARY,

CHAINS

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, W. of cor.

53.00 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains SW.

58.60 Ravine, drains SW.

69.40 Ravine, drains SW.

77.92 The cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, monumented with an unmarked trapstone, 13X8X6 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone. This point correlates well with other existing original corners and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 15 ins. in the ground to solid rock and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base to top, with brass cap mkd.

Deposit the unmarked cornerstone alongside the iron post.
