40.80	Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, drains N.
70.70	Trail road, bears N. and S.; enter rolling land.
71.90	Improved road, bears NW. and SE.
76.20	Fence, bears NW. and SE.
80.30	<p>The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12.</p> <p>Land, nearly level to rolling. Soil, sandy clay and rocky. Undergrowth, sagebrush, greasewood and native grass.</p>
	<p>N. 0° 01' W., bet. secs. 1 and 2.</p> <p>Over rolling land, through scattered undergrowth.</p>
