Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by  
D. H. Barker and E. L. Bridges,  
U.S. Deputy Surveyors, in 1879.

The cor. of Tps. 26 and 27 N., Rs. 51 and 52 E.,  
monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., firmly set  
showing 6 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as  
described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey  
of the south bdy. of T. 27 N., R. 52 E., executed under  
Group No. 201.

N. 89° 17' W., bet. secs. 1 and 36.

Over rolling land, covered with scattered sagebrush and  
native grass.

23.50 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains N.

40.10 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36, at  
proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence  
of the original corner.

Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24  
ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.

52.30 Ridge, bears N. and S.

80.20 The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, monumented with a  
wooden post, 2 ins. square, 36 ins. long, firmly set in  
a mound of stone, with illegible scribe marks visible.

At the corner point

Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24  
ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.
