Kearney) monumented with a wooden post, 3 ins. square, 24 ins. long, plainly scribed T28N on N. face and T27N on S. face, with 6 grooves on the N., S., E. and W. faces, firmly set in a mound of stone, bears N. 89° 58' E., 4.82 chs. dist. Add the marks AM and bury the post 6 ins. below the surface of the ground.</p> <p>From this same corner, the cor. of Tps. 27 and 28 N., Rs. 52 E., hereinbefore described, bears S. 0° 01' W., 5.11 chs. dist.</p>
