The elevation ranges from about 5,300 to 6,800 ft. above sea level. The soil is sandy clay loam and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, greasewood and native grass. There are scattered juniper and pinon pine on the higher elevations.</div> <div>Nevada Highway No. 278, crosses from NE. to SW., entering in sec. 5 and leaving in sec. 7. Further access into the township is provided by numerous secondary and trail roads.</div> <div>There are oil wells located in sections 7 and 8.</div> <div>Principal users of the township are cattlemen.</div>	
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
