Reestablishment of a Portion of the Survey Executed by
W. M. Kearney, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, in 1909.

From the cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, on the S. bdy.
of the Tp., monumented with an aluminum post, 2½ ins.
diam., firmly set showing 6 ins. above ground, with
aluminum cap mkd. as described in the field notes of T.
27 N., R. 51 E., executed concurrently under this same
Group.

N. 0° 03' W., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over gently rolling land, covered with sagebrush and
native grass.

0.40 Trail road, bears NNW. and SSE.

40.01 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, monumented with a
wooden post, 3 ins. square, 30 ins. long, firmly set in
a mound of earth and plainly mkd. ¼ on W. face.

At the corner point

Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24
ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.

Deposit the original cornerstone and set a steel fence
post, 5½ ft. long, alongside the aluminum post.

N. 0° 01' E., beginning new measurement.

Over gently rolling land.

12.20 Big Pole Creek, 30 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course E.

32.70 Trail road, bears NW. and SE.

39.98 The cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, monumented with
the decayed remains of a wooden post, loosely set in a
mound of earth, with illegible scribe marks visible.

At the corner point

Set an aluminum post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24
ins. in the ground, with aluminum cap mkd.
