

TOWNSHIP 28 NORTH, RANGE 51 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS	GENERAL DESCRIPTION
	<p>The area resurveyed within Township 28 North, Range 51 East, ranges from about 5,300 to 5,500 ft. above sea level, and is mostly rolling land. The soil varies from sandy clay loam in the lower elevations to rocky in the higher elevations. The vegetation consists of sagebrush, greasewood and sparse native grass, with junipers in the higher elevations.</p> <p>The surveyed portion of the township is drained by Big Pole Creek, Little Pole Creek and other washes draining generally east.</p> <p>Principal users of the area are cattlemen and access into the area is provided by two unimproved roads, that cross through sections 12 and 36.</p>
