

TOWNSHIP 39 NORTH, RANGE 18 EAST, MDM, NEVADA

CHAINS

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area resurveyed within Township 39 North, Range 18 East, ranges from about 6,200 to 7,500 ft. above sea level, and is mountainous. The soil is sandy clay, gravelly and rocky. The vegetation consists of sagebrush and native grass. There are scattered juniper, mahogany and aspen in some areas.

The area is drained by Hays Canyon, which drains irregularly westerly through the northern portion of the township.

No mineral formations of consequence were noted during the survey.

Principal users of the area are cattlemen. Access into the township is provided by desert trail roads through the township.
