Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by
U.S. Deputy Surveyors C. F. Putnam and W. F. Benson
in 1880 and the Resurvey Executed by
U.S. Surveyor W. Hoffman
in 1914

The cor. of secs. 1 and 12, on the E. bdy. of the Tp.,
monumented with a basalt stone 15X10X6 ins., firmly set
9 ins. in the ground, mkd. with 5 grooves on S. face
and 1 groove on N. face, with a mound of stone west.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Deposit the original cornerstone alongside the iron
post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft.
high, W. of cor.

N. 0° 19' E., along the E. bdy. of sec. 1.

sagebrush and buckbrush.

The W ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 6, T. 39 N., R. 20 E.,
monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set
showing 10 ins. above ground, with a mound of stone 3
ft. base, 2 ft. high E. of cor., with brass cap mkd. as
described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey
of T. 39 N., R. 20 E.
