Reestablishment of a Portion of the Survey Executed by  
J. D. Archer, U.S. Transitman  
in 1911.

From the closing cor. of secs. 35 and 36, on the S.  
bdy. of the Tp.

N. 0° 01' E., bet. secs. 35 and 36.

Over mountainous land, through scattered sagebrush,  
bunchgrass and juniper.

33.86 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, monumented with an  
iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone,  
with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of  
the survey of the subdivisional lines of T. 40 N., R.  
18 E., executed under Group No. 5. Add the marks T40N  
R18E 1985 to the brass cap.

N. 0° 02' E., beginning new measurement.

Over mountainous land.

40.05 The cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, monumented with an  
iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of  
stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field  
notes of the survey of the subdivisional lines of T. 40  
N., R. 18 E., executed under Group No. 5. Add the  
marks 1985 to the brass cap.

EAST, bet. secs. 25 and 36.

Over mountainous land, through scattered sagebrush,  
bunchgrass and juniper.

24.26 Intersect the W. bdy. of sec. 31, T. 40 N., R. 19 E.

Point for the closing cor. of secs. 25 and 36,  
established at the intersection of the line between  
secs. 25 and 36, of the 1911 survey and on the W. bdy.  
of sec. 31, T. 40 N., R. 19 E., dependently resurveyed  
concurrently under this same Group.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., on solid  
rock over a cross (X), in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base  
to top, with brass cap mkd.
