	<p>T40N R18E R19E ¼  S 24 </p> <p>1985</p> <p>From this corner, the W ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 19, T. 40 N., R. 19 E., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the W. bdy. of T. 40 N., R. 19 E., executed concurrently under this same Group, bears N. 2° 20' E., 7.18 chs. dist.</p> <p>From this same corner, the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 23 and 24, hereinbefore described, bears N. 89° 55' W.</p> <p>From this same corner, the point for the E ¼ sec. cor. 24, hereinbefore described, bears S. 89° 55' E.</p> <hr/> <p>From the cor. of secs. 13, 14, 23 and 24. N. 0° 02' E., between sec. 13 and 14. Over mountainous land, through scattered sagebrush, bunchgrass and juniper.</p>	
39.92	<p>The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 13 and 14, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the survey of the subdivisional lines of T. 40 N., R. 18 E., executed under Group No. 5. Add the marks T40N R18E 1985 to the brass cap.</p> <hr/> <p>N. 0° 02' E., beginning new measurement. Over mountainous land.</p>	
39.93	<p>The cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the survey of the subdivisional lines of T. 40 N., R. 18 E., executed under Group No. 5. Add the marks 1985 to the brass cap.</p> <hr/> <p>EAST, bet. secs. 12 and 13. Over mountainous land, through scattered sagebrush, bunchgrass and juniper.</p>	
28.90	<p>Intersect the W. bdy. of sec. 18, T. 40 N., R. 19 E.</p> <p>Point for the closing cor. of secs. 12 and 13, established at the intersection of the line between secs. 12 and 13, of the 1911 survey and on the W. bdy. of sec. 18, T. 40 N., R. 19 E., dependently resurveyed concurrently under this same Group.</p>
