N. 0° 01' E., bet. secs. 11 and 12. Over mountainous land, through scattered sagebrush, bunchgrass and juniper.</p>																
39.98	<p>The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 11 and 12, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the survey of the subdivisional lines of T. 40 N., R. 18 E., executed under Group No. 5. Add the marks T40N R18E 1985 to the brass cap.</p> <hr/> <p>N. 0° 01' E., beginning new measurement. Over rolling land.</p>																
40.13	<p>The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12, monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the survey of the subdivisional lines of T. 40 N., R. 18 E., executed under Group No. 5. Add the marks 1985 to the brass cap.</p> <hr/> <p>S. 89° 59' E., bet. secs. 1 and 12. Over rolling land, through scattered sagebrush and bunchgrass.</p>

Point for the closing cor. of secs. 1 and 12, established at the intersection of the line between secs. 1 and 12, of the 1911 survey and on the W. bdy. of sec. 7, T. 40 N., R. 19 E., dependently resurveyed concurrently under this same Group.
