Archer, monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., exposed 18 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the retracement and dependent resurvey of a portion of T. 40 N., R. 18 E., executed concurrently under this same Group.
38.16	The N $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 6, T. 40 N., R. 19 E., hereinafter described.
39.95	The standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 31, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set and exposed 14 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd. as described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of the Eighth Standard Parallel North, through Range 19 East, executed under Group No. 5.
